

Kings Forest – Waste Collection Facts and Rules:

- Waste is collected on Mondays and Thursdays by Texas Pride Disposal, our contractor.
- Holidays – if a scheduled day falls on New Year’s Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day there will be no pickup. Service will resume the next scheduled day.
- Items for pickup shall be placed out in view from the street no earlier than 7:00 pm the evening prior to pick up and empty containers should be removed from street view by the evening of the pickup day. This includes yard waste. Texas Pride may pick up as early as 7:00 am on scheduled days.
- Up to five items per scheduled day will be picked up at the garage door or outside a side -yard gate if the garage door is not accessible. On heavy days, a total of up to 10 items (containers, bags, and individual piles of trimmings per below) will be picked up per scheduled day, but these items must be placed at the end of the individual driveway.
- Residential refuse and general yard waste must be placed in personal trash cans of 20 to 96 gallons or bags not exceeding 40 pounds in weight each.
- Tree, shrub, or brush trimmings must be piled neatly curbside in individual bundles not exceeding 4 feet in length by 3 feet high by 3 feet wide, and branches may not exceed 6 inches in diameter. Each such pile counts as one item.
- Texas Pride will not pick up dirt, rocks, bricks, concrete, liquid paints, fuels, oils, tires, pesticides, fertilizer, and batteries; nor any other materials deemed hazardous waste; nor waste generated by a private contractor (including yard waste generated by a private contractor).
- Up to two bulky waste items such as appliances/furniture/mattresses/carpeting (tied in bundles under 40 pounds)/fencing (nails removed, tied and bundled under 4’ in length) will be collected on each service day (refrigerators/freezers must be drained of Freon and have a bill to validate such service was obtained).
- Texas Pride may provide special collections exceeding the limits above by prior agreement with an individual homeowner. Contact Texas Pride to arrange special collections and direct payment to Texas Pride.
