General Information – Kings Forest Community Pool

2615 Woods Estates (nearest intersection - Woods Estates and Twin Grove Dr.)

Hours of Operation:

Pool hours are dawn to dusk daily, except Mondays, when the pool is closed for chemical treatment.

Swim At Your Own Risk:

Our pool has **no Lifeguards** – residents must agree to a liability waiver and pool rules. A 911 call station is located just outside the gate, or you may use your cell phone to call in an emergency.

Who May Use The Pool:

Use of the pool is limited to Kings Forest residents and no more than four guests per family at a time. Given the small size of our pool, we do not allow, nor do we receive reciprocal access to the other community pools in Kingwood (Kings Forest residents may apply to Kingwood Service Association and a pay a fee for access to the other pools).

Residents that wish to have parties with more than 4 guests may rent the pool and or community room – see our website at https://kingsforest.us/kings-forest-pool-and-community-room/ for details. Use of the pool for lessons (other than one on one lessons for residents) requires approval of the Board.

To Obtain Access:

Instructions and the necessary forms are available at our website https://kingsforest.us/kings-forest-pool-and-community-room/. You will receive an electronic key (FOB) for access. The first pool fob is \$10 and the second is \$15, due at time of registration. There will be a \$50 charge for replacement fobs. If your fob is lost or stolen, you must notify the association immediately.

Please note: It takes about a week to get the fob once you submit your paperwork to PMG.

Using the Entry Gates:

The parking lot gate should be left open and is never locked. Once you get to the pool gate, you will notice a black rectangle on the stucco wall to your left. Wave your fob over this, the light will change from red to green, and the gate to the pool can now be opened by lifting the mechanical latch.

To leave, there is a button on your right, over the counter. Push this button to unlock the gate, and again lift the mechanical latch by reaching through the access hole in the gate.

Key Rules:

- As there are no Lifeguards, an adult must accompany any children under the age of 15.
- Also, this is a community pool so **please pick up after yourselves** and leave the pool area as clean, or cleaner, than when you arrived. That includes the bathrooms. Parents of young children should accompany their children to the bathroom.
- Follow all posted rules on signs at the pool
